Cruising Chicago-Thursday July 15

Leave from East Towne parking lot (by the food court) at 8:30 return at 6:00

Starting from Old Navy Pier in downtown Chicago, we will board a cruise boat on the Chicago River to take us through Chicago's world renowned architecture in class, style and comfort! Learn about the architecture and design of over 50 buildings while also hearing about the history of the Chicago River including who they reversed the river's flow so that waste from the city's factories and stockyards wouldn't back up in the city.

After the tour, we will explore the Old Navy Pier with its many shops, music, sights of Lake Michigan and other boats. If you're looking for an aerial view of the city, you can ride the big Ferris Wheel at Navy Pier!

We will be boarding the riverboat in Dubuque, eating lunch from an onboard lunch buffet, complete with dessert and capped off with a Fountain of Shrimp at the end of the cruise!

The House on the Rock was built by an architect and his son. The architect had been dismissed by Frank Lloyd Wright with the declaration, "I wouldn't hire you to design a cheese crate or a chicken coop". Wow, did they show old Frank! Opened to the public in 1961, the House is now only a small portion of a magical experience. **The climb to the house can be quite a bit of exercise, so people should be ambulatory and in fairly good shape to go on this trip.**

Cost: \$50 includes tour and sandwich lunch.

General Information about Arc Day Trippers

- Transportation to and from Madison meeting points is provided via vans, buses or motor coaches depending on the trip size. While manual wheelchairs and walkers can be accommodated, people need to be able to transfer to the vehicles with physical assistance. Please contact Duncan McNelly if a person requires a lift for transportation to discuss possible arrangements.
- We have priced the trips to be as affordable as possible while covering our expenses. Payment arrangements can be made to allow a person to take the trip of their choosing as long as full payment is made within the calendar year the trip is taken. So if you want to take a trip in March and need to pay in monthly installments through December, no problem! Limited sponsorships are available. Please contact Duncan McNelly to discuss payment arrangements or sponsorships.
- Staffing ratios are at minimum, one broker for every five people who have disabilities. For people who require more support, it is the responsibility of the agency or the individual to arrange for needed additional support. **Support staff who accompany an individual will need to pay the full cost of the trip.**
- **While all trips are coordinated with safety as the top priority, the Arc-WI can not assume responsibility for any injuries or accidents.**
